

Excel High School U.S. History I (grades 9-12)*

This course will study the history of the United States from the Pre-Columbian era to Reconstruction. Each week the student will read from their textbook, answer study guide questions, and do occasional worksheets and maps. In class, we will review the past week's homework and students will take notes from lecture. The first semester will include a weekly topical project. The second semester will include a 5 to 7 page research paper. There will be two tests per semester, one midterm and one semester final.
