High School English (grades 10*-12) (British Literature and Composition)

Tuition: \$40

This comprehensive high school English course will study examples of British literature from different eras and genres. We will study the historical and cultural settings in which they were written, the purposes for which they were written, and the lives of the authors. Each week the student will read the assigned literature and create a study guide. The composition portion will focus heavily on the six primary essay types along with some creative writing. There will be two tests per semester, one midterm and one final, as well as random pop-quizzes.
