Course Description:

This course will cover a brief introduction to Microsoft Office/Google products, an overview of photography, advertising/journalism, layout and design software. There will be discussion on potential job opportunities in the advertising/marketing field and its trends. Students will help promote and photograph SPIRIT DAY, sell ads for the yearbook, and help take candid photos for the yearbook. They will help complete the EXCEL Yearbook for 2021-2022. There will be a short lecture weekly and hands on time with the yearbook online software and other software applications. Grades will come from one page paper assignments, quizzes, tests, participation in SPIRIT DAY, and completion of assigned yearbook pages. Students should plan to spend 2-3 hours per week on work.
